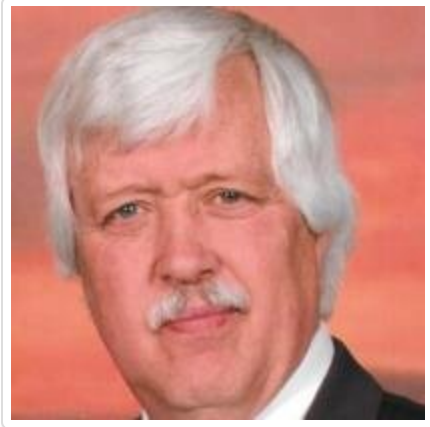




Alfred Music Jr.
