Barbara Ann Tyler Bishop, 88, formerly of Pensacola, Florida, passed into Heaven Wednesday, December 14, 2022, in Lakeland after a brief illness. She was surrounded by her loving family as she went peacefully.

Barbara was born in Biloxi, Mississippi, to Ildred and Guy Tyler. She remained in Biloxi until she married in 1951 and became a military wife who traveled widely during her husband's career. She eventually settled in Pensacola, where she worked in retail before retiring to care for her mother. A member of the Parish of Little Flower Catholic Church, Barbara volunteered at the Mother Teresa Mission for fifteen years. She enjoyed fishing with her mother, traveling with her family, and working crossword puzzles.
