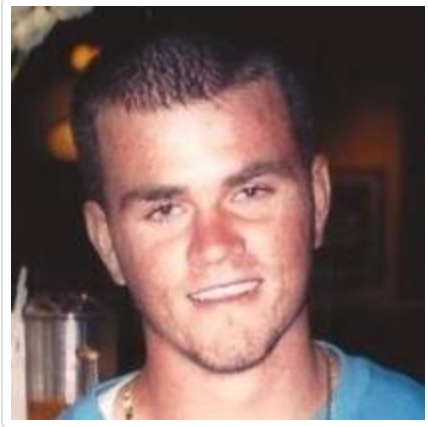




Donald Colt Graham

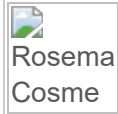
