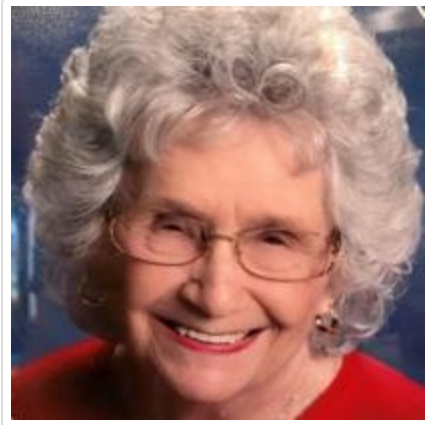




Hilda B. Goldsmith

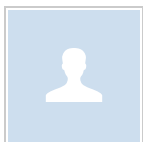
