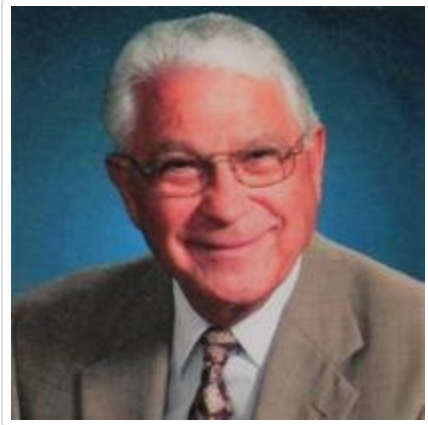




James Wade Lipham
