Joseph Edward Lovette, 38, of Lakeland, Florida, went home to Heaven on Monday, May 20, 2024 after a courageous battle against aggressive brain cancer. Joseph was born February 6, 1986 in Raleigh, North Carolina, to Jerry and Elizabeth (Lee) Medina Lovette.
