“ I shared the office next to Kristina, with only 1-dividing wall between us, our doors are next to each other which indicates how closely we worked. I remember Kristina from her 1st days with the City as I was a member of the HR interview panel who selected Kristina. She was self-motivated to learn all aspects of HR and being her best self. She excelled in learning and applied it to become a key contributor in HR. We relied on her calm demeanor and passion to do the right thing for each challenging case she handled.

Often, we were the last 2-stragglers leaving HR after 5PM as we were both working late to complete something we thought couldn't wait until the next day.
