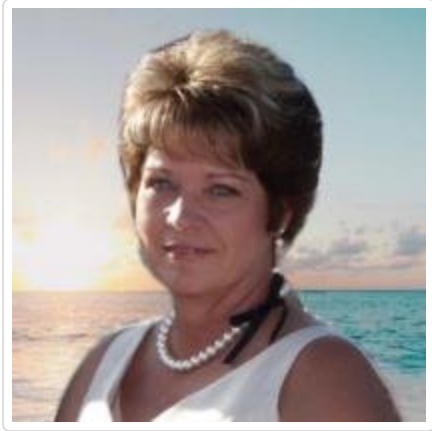




## Noreen Marianne Albury
