



## Rev. William Scott Littleton

December 18, 1946 - January 8, 2023

The Reverend William Scott Littleton, age 76 of Lakeland, Florida, went Home to Glory, due to a fatal lung disease, on January 8, 2023.

He was preceded in death by his son, Todd Phillip Littleton who went home to Glory at the age of almost 3 months old. Rev. Littleton is survived by his wife, Nancy G. Littleton, four children, Steve (Michon) Parker, Kimberly Littleton, Scott Parker and Tiffany (Chris) Nelson, along with 9 grandchildren, 1 great grandchild, and a black Labrador named Levi.
