Tom, built many feed lots, test facilities, for the University of Florida in Gainesville, FL. and Texas Tech University in Lubbock, Texas. Tom was a consultant in many countries around the world helping to improve their livestock facilities and plants.

He was an avid supporter of Polk County 4-H and FFA. As an advocate for children, he supported many in their livestock projects; he contributed to raising more children that we could ever count, backing many in their livestock projects.
