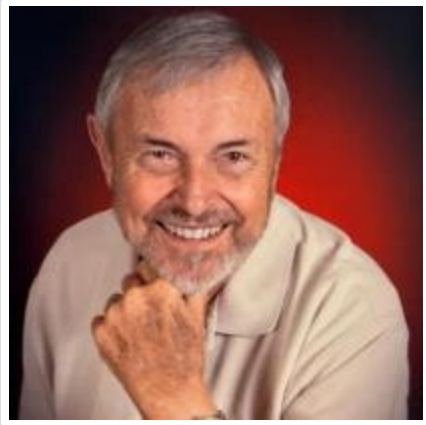




Thomas G. Wagner

Thomas George Wagner 83, of Lakeland, passed away at home in his sleep on October 7, 2023, after a short battle with pancreatic cancer.
