Warren William Gallagher, 59, of Lakeland, Florida peacefully graduated from his earthly life to eternal life surrounded by his family on January 2nd, 2026, after a courageous battle with Cancer.

Born in Hempstead, Long Island, New York on August 5th, 1966, to Bruce and Claire Gallagher. He was the first of three boys. At a young age Warren displayed a passion for church and especially following Jesus. In his younger years he would attend many long island cougar hockey games with his father.

There he would follow a passion for hockey, learning everything about the team, players, and coaches, even making suggestions to the coaches on who to play that night. As Warren became a teenager he fell in love with Christian music. He especially loved the band, Petra.

He served in ministry with Tres Dias of northern NJ and Kairos prison ministry. Entering college years he attended Trinity Bible College in Ellendale North Dakota. It was here that he met his Wife Patricia Dando. Shortly after college they married in 1988.

Together they had three children, Chirstopher, Jessica, and John, all of Lakeland. Warren is survived by his Wife Patricia Gallagher, their 3 children Christopher, Jessica, and John as well as his mother Claire Gallagher of Budd

Lake, NJ, Brothers, Bruce and his wife Stephanie also of Budd Lake, NJ.

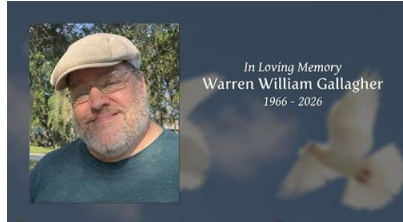
